Key Highlights of EC Regime

Guidelines for Assessment of Environment Compensation to be levied for Violation of Plastic Waste Management Rules,2016.” Published in September 2022

Key Highlights From the EC Regime

- EC fine will be levied at Rs. 5000/ton and will be doubled on 2nd & 3rd violation .
- Closure/Seizure of Unit, Revocation of Consent & Certificate and Penalty as per section 15(1) of EPA 1986.
- EC to be levied not obtaining Registration on the Centralized Portal .
- Provisions of PWM Rule specifying the Violators and Violations in detail. Violators identified – PIBOs, PWPs, Manufacturer, Local Bodies , Street Vendors/Retailers, Commercial Establishment, distributors/stockist.
- The Environment Compensation, as applicable, will be imposed by CPCB on the PIBOs functioning in more than two states w.r.t in case of non-compliance to EPR targets and responsibilities in these directions.
- The Environment Compensation shall be imposed by the concerned SPCB on the PIBOs not functioning in more than two states/UTs, plastic waste processors including recyclers and other processors –waste to oil/energy, w.r.t non-conformity with EPR targets underpinned under these guidelines.
- Minimum and Maximum Value of EC to be levied.
- Delay in the deposition of EC will attract Financial Penalty at an interest rate of 12% or 24% p.a.
